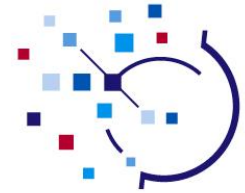
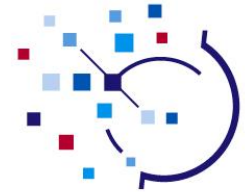


Closing Plenary: Copenhagen April 2010

 - Harmonization of SNOMED's anatomy hierarchy with FMA [Foundational Model of Anatomy] is a key step to better represent clinically important content such as disorders and procedures by creating a more complete and logically correct model of anatomy.

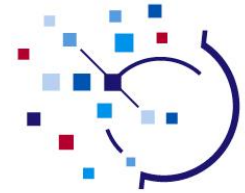
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Anesthesia Special Interest Group

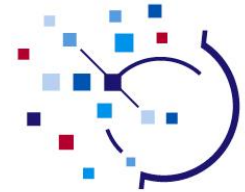
- The single most important thing to emerge from our discussions for the Community of Practice was:

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GP/FP Refset & ICPC Mapping PG

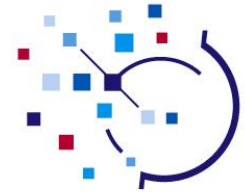
- The single most important thing to emerge from our discussions for the Community of Practice was:

Event, Condition, Episode Model

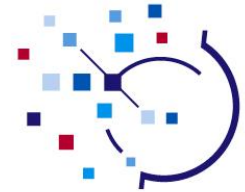
- The single most important thing to emerge from our discussions for the Community of Practice was:

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IHTSDO Workbench RefSet Module Project Group

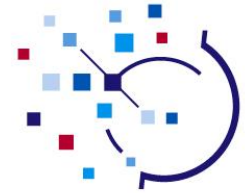
- The single most important thing to emerge from our discussions for the Community of Practice was:

 - International review window is open for latest version
 - Bugs and fixes release available 17 May
 - Final user acceptance testing 20 May
 - Sign off by project group 21 May

 - Importance of concentrating on the imperatives of family practice is crucial both to the responsibilities of the SIG and the wider SNOMED community.

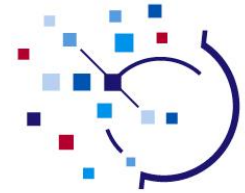
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Implementation SIG

 - We require a coherent service management process wrapper across IHTSDO products
 - We need guidance for implementers to understand how to put post-coordination into practice

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iPaLM WG

- The single most important thing to emerge from our discussions for the Community of Practice was:
 - We are back, action plan is being reviewed.



Machine & Human Readable Concept Model Project

 - Enthusiasm for a collaboration of terminology binding to build an end-to-end prototype/demonstrator, showing how SNOMED CT and an information model may be safely bound together.

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Mapping Special Interest Group

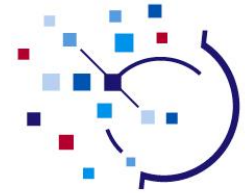
- The single most important thing to emerge from our discussions for the Community of Practice was:

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Mapping SNOMED CT to ICD-10 Project group

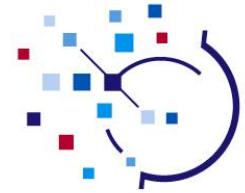
- The single most important thing to emerge from our discussions for the Community of Practice was:

 - Synergy of front line clinical experience and technical standards expertise will result in better outcomes and fitness for purpose.

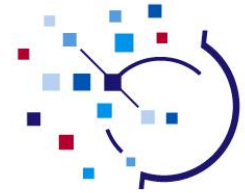
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Observable & Investigation Model Project

 - A draft of a simple friendly definition of observable entity: an observable entity (in SNOMED CT) is a specification of some characteristic you intend to find out about something, optionally including how you intend to find it out.

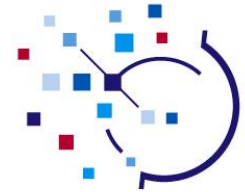
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Pharmacy Special Interest Group

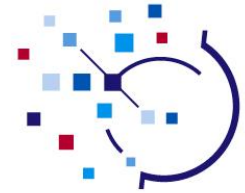
- The single most important thing to emerge from our discussions for the Community of Practice was:
 - Through the work of the Medicines Model re-design, we have worked with members of the Technical Committee to formulate a proposal to represent classifiable numbers in SNOMED CT.

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Pre-coordination Roadmap Project Group

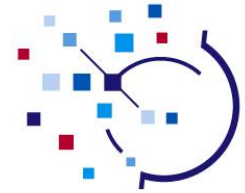
- The single most important thing to emerge from our discussions for the Community of Practice was:
 - Agreement that we should catalogue patterns of pre-coordination, and for any patterns that are disallowed, we should permit exceptions based on use frequency, and also we should provide implementation advice for post-coordination using the concept model and/or information model(s) in combination.



Request Submission Project

- The single most important thing to emerge from our discussions for the Community of Practice was:
 - The group spent our session reviewing activity over the last six months and identifying:
 - Next steps
 - Interdependencies with our policy and other processes
 - The workload of the group required a longer session next time

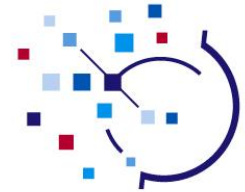
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Substance Hierarchy Redesign Project

- The single most important thing to emerge from our discussions for the Community of Practice was:
 - The SHR project needs more participation, outside of the pharmaceutical product and allergy realm, who can provide feedback on the proposed substance definition and model, or the model will be at risk of being too parochial.

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Translation Special Interest Group

- The single most important thing to emerge from our discussions for the Community of Practice was:
 - Handover of the responsibility for the Translation Guidelines and Management Guidelines to the SIG
 - Discussion and feedback on “IHTSDO’s Role in Translation”
 - National translation updates from 6 countries

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Translation Quality Assessment Project Group

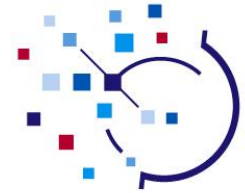
- The single most important thing to emerge from our discussions for the Community of Practice was:
 - In consultation with the selected contractor we have defined a working plan for creating the Translation Quality Assessment toolkit.
 - The expected product will be delivered by September 15th and will be presented at the next IHTSDO meeting in October.

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Translation Standard Processes Project Group

- The single most important thing to emerge from our discussions for the Community of Practice was:
 - First version of Guidelines for Management of Translation of SNOMED CT was approved and published in April.
 - Revised version of Guidelines for Translation of SNOMED CT was approved by the MB during the conference and will soon be published.
 - Discussion about revision cycles, how to collect feedback on both Guidelines using questionnaires
 - This PG has now been officially closed.
